The Minister for Local Government has established a Regional Governance Working Group to provide advice on the future of local government.

The Regional Governance Working Group has developed an options paper for widespread community consultation and feedback.

The working group holds meetings on a regular basis and receives secretarial support from the Department of Local Government.
